General Statement of Duties

Employee will perform responsible technical laboratory work in a water treatment plant necessary for the monitoring of municipal treatment plant operations.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

An employee in this class performs and oversees a variety of chemical, biological, and microbiological tests designed to produce safe operation of domestic and commercial water production. The employee may be the primary laboratory staff in a small operation or a journey level analyst in a larger laboratory with more workload. Work includes establishing work schedules and timetables, troubleshooting process problems, conducting laboratory procedures, and preparing necessary reports and maintenance of records and files in a state-certified laboratory. The employee is subject to hazards associated with chemical work including exposure to electrical current, chemicals, fumes, odors, dusts, mists, gases, and poor ventilation. The employee may be required to wear a respirator. Work also may be subject to the final standards of OSHA on blood borne pathogens. Work is performed under general supervision and is reviewed for conformance to testing and reporting procedures and accuracy. Efficient and accurate computer skills and ability to work with State officials are essential.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to perform the basic life functions of stooping, crouching, reaching, standing, lifting, fingering, grasping, talking, and repetitive motions. Must be able to perform light work exerting up to 20 pounds of force occasionally; and/or up to 10 pounds of force frequently, and/or a negligible amount of force constantly to move objects. Must possess visual acuity to prepare and analyze laboratory results, data, and figures, to operate a microcomputer, and to perform visual inspection of measurement devices. Efficient and accurate computer skills are essential.

Desirable Education and Experience

Graduation from a community college with a degree in Chemistry, Environmental Science, or related field and related laboratory and/or water treatment operation experience.

Special Requirements

Possession of Process Control and Bacteriological Laboratory Analyst certifications or ability to obtain within 6 months of hire and Grade C, B or A Surface Water Treatment Plant Operator certification or ability to obtain within 12 months of hire.
