General Statement of Duties

Performs responsible technical and skilled work in the operation, maintenance, and repair of equipment in the water plant and pumping stations.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

Considerable knowledge of: the installation, repair, and maintenance of the mechanical, plumbing, and hydraulic components of the water facility; the occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions of the work; tools, parts, and methods associated with diagnosing, repairing, and maintaining equipment; carpentry and masonry; electrical wiring and ability to diagnose and replace some parts; SCADA systems trouble-shooting, maintenance and repair; application of information technology to maintain, repair, locate and order parts as needed while maintain accurate records; skill in the use and care of tools of the trade; skill in mechanical, plumbing, and some electrical trades work; ability to detect malfunctioning of pumps and motors by observation, sound, and chart readings, and to take proper remedial action; ability to read and follow schematic drawings, blueprints, and written and oral instructions.; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and supervisor; and the ability to paint.

Physical Requirements

Must be able to physically perform the basic life operational functions of climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, fingering, grasping, feeling, hearing, and repetitive motions. Must be able to perform heavy work exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally; and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently; and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly. Must possess the visual acuity to operate machines and equipment including close inspection of moving and small parts, using measurement devices, perform assembly and fabrication of parts, prepare maintenance records and operate a computer terminal.

Desirable Education and Experience

Graduation from high school supplemented by courses in mechanical or plumbing trades, and utility mechanical system maintenance experience including pump repair; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Special Requirements

Possession of a valid North Carolina driver's license. Ability to obtain commercial driver's license within six months. Ability to obtain Class I Maintenance Technologist certification within one year.
