The City of Henderson is currently accepting applications for the leaf collection season. These are temporary seasonal jobs only. The work will begin mid to late October 2019 and end around mid to late January 2020.

Features of the Job

An employee in this position may drive a dump truck and/or perform manual work in the collection of leaves from the roadside. The job requires working Monday through Friday from 7:30AM to 4:00PM and Saturday from 7:30AM to 12:00 Noon. Employee must be able to perform manual labor and abide by safety rules and regulations. Work subjects the employee to outside environmental conditions, noise and vibration. Employee will operate truck vacuum and/or rake to collect leaves while following relevant safety practices and procedures in equipment operation.

Physical Requirements

Ability to perform continuous heavy manual labor at a steady pace and in varying weather conditions; ability to walk for extensive periods of time; ability to perform the basic life operational functions of climbing, stooping, kneeling, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, grasping and/or repetitive motions. Must be able to perform heavy lifting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects.

Desirable Education and Experience

High School diploma or GED and/or experience in unskilled maintenance work; or an equivalent of combination of education and experience.

Dump Truck Driver must possess valid NC issued Class B Commercial Driver License.

Note: A pre-employment background screening will be performed for all selected candidates. A criminal conviction record will not necessarily exclude you from employment. Factors such as age at the time of offense, rehabilitation efforts, how recent the offense was, nature of the crime and type of job for which you are applying will be considered.
